To date we have utilised \$26,000 across the country. We are increasingly seeing requests come in not just for education but, psychological counselling, physiotherapy and speech therapy. A slow process but it is moving in the right direction. Our critical financial relief package for families continues and that has reached \$110,000 in this financial year.

7. Please describe the impact that the TFN funding has had on your organisation.

TFN has given us hope that we were moving in the right direction and a freedom to continue this route financially. I can't stress how important that was. TFN with Ellie's updates also gave me information re grant prospects and I have just been norified that we won a \$15,000 grant for children in NSW for Education.

We are now seeking to employ an education administrator on a casual part time basis to ease the pressure on the volunteers.

e.g. Having a dedicated Volunteer Coordinator has enabled us to increase the number of volunteers who support our program and to develop a more in-depth training program to support more young people...

8. How many people have been supported by programs or activities that were funded by the TFN donations?

We have had 24 young people on active support, 5 are on hold as we search for adequate support close to the parent's homes and 2 are still to complete their applications on line.

9. Please tell us a short story about someone who has benefited from this funding.

Penny was diagnosed with a retinolastoma at the age of 2 years. Sadly she progressed to a brain tumour as well and thus came under our care. Treatment did finally succeed but significant issues remained. Now 15 years of age and with limited vision she is doing well at school in Tasmania and hoping to complete year 12.

We have directed the TFN money directly to our Better Tomorrows Program and as noted by the end of the financial year it is expected that 100% will be utilised.

We contacted all paediatric rehabilitation units attached to all paediatric hospital across Australia and highlighted what we could offer the families who are not covered by government agencies. Education support remains outside of NDIS and families are now emailing us directly and asking the question of what we can do. Thus the importance of having a designated education administrator to connect and follow these families through to a satisfactory outcome, has become critical. We have a board meeting next week to discuss this thoroughly.

Greater awareness of Brainchild Foundation, greater costs and time required in achieving resources. Families struggling more with the cost of fuel and food and thus more requests.
